

HERITAGE OR NATURAL ENVIRONMENT AWARD

Guidelines

1. The aim of the Selwyn District Council Heritage or Natural Environment Award is to promote and celebrate sustainable management of heritage and environmental resources within Selwyn, including:
 - encouraging efforts that are managing and caring for resources in a better way.
 - promoting awareness of the importance of maintaining our heritage or environmental resources for future generations.
 - recognising and rewarding activities that show sustainable management.
2. Any project that promotes the sustainable management of our heritage or natural and man-made resources in the Selwyn District, including:
 - projects that collate and protect our history; or
 - projects that encourage more efficient use of water, reduce soil erosion, promote clean air or clean water, encourage conservation of indigenous or valued plants and animals, save energy, achieve better pest control or reduce environmental risks is eligible for the award.
3. Preference will be given to projects that are underway or have been completed.
4. Entries are sought from projects that fulfil the above criteria. They can be initiated and managed by individuals, community groups, or commercial and industrial companies.
5. Supporting material (such as plans, photographs, models and videos) is welcome.

Notes for Entrants

- Nominations** You may nominate yourself, or bona fide organisations, associations, societies, clubs or residents may make nominations. (NB where an organisation, association, etc, is making a nomination, two executive officers are required to sign and record the title of their office on the nomination form).
- Evaluation** As the judges make their decisions based on the quality of information in the application form, we welcome the inclusion of extra information in applications. All information is confidential to the judges and will be returned to the applicant if requested.
- Presentations** All data presented will be made available to the judges for their consideration.
- Decision** Two judges will take part in the judging of the winner of the award. The judges' decision is final and binding.
- General** The successful nominee for this award will not be eligible for nomination in the following year. Nominees not successful in any one year may be re-nominated in subsequent years. Unsuccessful nominations shall not be carried forward to the following year.
- This award cannot be made posthumously.
- An award will not necessarily be presented annually.
- Closing date** 4pm Monday 19th May 2008. Nomination forms must be returned to the Selwyn District Council Service Centres or Libraries at Leeston, Darfield, Lincoln or Rolleston, or by post to Joy Farrington, Selwyn District Council, PO Box 90, Rolleston.
