

Mountain bike: We've got loads of trails to suit all abilities, so come on, on ya bike!


Camp: Relax, unwind and try out one of our Selwyn campsites for a night or two.



Most of our Selwyn townships have local domains and reserves available for you to use. Here are some fun ideas to try:


Frisbee – Frisbee is a fun, relaxed game to try out! Either just pass between friends or get a group together and have a go at Ultimate Frisbee!


