As mid-winter approaches, Waikirikiri Selwyn is preparing to celebrate Matariki - the rising of the Matariki star cluster that signals the start of the Māori New Year.

Council events will run across the district from Friday 13 until Saturday 28 June, with the main evening event Mānawatia a Matariki on Thursday 19 June at Rolleston Town Centre. There will be light displays, kapa haka performances, live music, story-telling and interactive activities for all ages to connect with Māori culture.

On Friday 13 June, Kāi Tahu musician Ariana Tikao will be performing at Te Ara Ātea. Ariana will demonstrate the unique sounds of Aoteoroa's ancestral instruments, sing waiata and recite her moving poetry.
