## Matariki Events

**As mid-winter approaches, Waikirikiri Selwyn is preparing to celebrate Matariki - the rising of the Matariki star cluster that signals the start of the Māori New Year.**

Council events will run across the district from Friday 13 until Saturday 28 June, with the main evening event Mānawatia a Matariki on Thursday 19 June at Rolleston Town Centre. There will be light displays, kapa haka performances, live music, story-telling and interactive activities for all ages to connect with Māori culture.

On Friday 13 June, Kāi Tahu musician Ariana Tikao will be performing at Te Ara Ātea. Ariana will demonstrate the unique sounds of Aotearoa's ancestral instruments, sing waiata and recite her moving poetry.

Keen on stargazing? Don't miss a unique opportunity to learn about the stars, planets and constellations on a 60-minute tour with experts from Christchurch Astro Tours on Friday 20 June in Greenpark.

To give tamariki a taste of Māori crafts, after-school Matariki craft sessions are being held on Monday 23 June in Lincoln, and Thursday 26 June in West Melton.

Events will wrap up on Saturday 28 June when musical duo Loopy Tunes, sisters Leah and Siu host an interactive session of bilingual music, stories and fun for preschoolers at Te Ara Ātea.
