

Local Body Elections 2025

GET SET. GET REGISTERED.



If you want to vote in this year's local government elections now is the time to make sure you're enrolled.

Selwyn residents 18 or older and who are a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident are eligible to vote, if they are enrolled on the parliamentary electoral roll.

But you need to make sure your enrolments details are correct by Friday 1 August if you want to be mailed your voting papers.

If you miss the 1 August deadline, but you're eligible to vote, you can still vote but you'll have to request special voting papers from the Council's electoral officer.

Everyone on the electoral roll should have received an enrolment pack from the Electoral Commission. If your details were correct — then you don't need to do anything.

If you haven't received an enrolment update pack in the mail by now it may mean you're not enrolled, or your details are not up to date. This could be because you've recently moved into the district, changed addresses, or have turned 18 — and you'll need to update your details.

To enrol or update your details, visit **vote.nz** or call 0800 36 76 56.

You can also check a copy of the preliminary electoral roll at the Council offices or any Selwyn library and service centre, as well as the Arthur's Pass Store, Dunsandel Store, or Tai Tapu Store.

If you own property in the Selwyn district but live in another district you may be able to enrol as a non-resident ratepayer elector and vote in both areas. Check your eligibility and get more information at the Ratepayer Elector Enrolment Portal on the Council's website at

Upgrades on Lincoln Rolleston Road

From Monday 21 July until approximately 10 October 2025, major works will take place on Lincoln Rolleston Road, starting near the Selwyn Road intersection.

The project involves installing a new wastewater pipeline, along with upgrades to watermains, entranceways, stormwater systems, kerbing, and footpaths.

To reduce disruption, contractors are coordinating under a single traffic management plan, helping to avoid repeated road closures and shorten the construction period.

To safely complete this work while maintaining traffic flow, a tidal one-lane system will be in place. This means a one-way system will operate on the following schedule:

- 6am-2pm: One-way exit only from Rolleston
- 2pm-6am: One-way entry only into Rolleston

This arrangement allows traffic to flow with peak demand and will be clearly signposted, with detours in place.
