A barrier will be placed on the river 200m downstream of the Wolfes Road boat ramp.

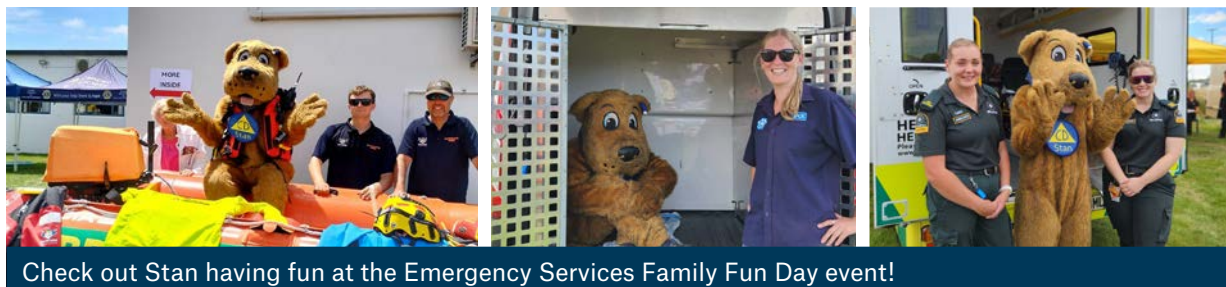
