You will require a permit if you move your stock on a road listed in Schedule A, B and C of the Stock Droving

We are receiving a large number of permit requests each day. To assist us to process your permit speedily, please provide:

- at least four days' notice where possible
- a map of the proposed route
- if crossing a state highway, confirmation that the NZTA (Fulton Hogan) has granted approval.
- if crossing a railway line, confirmation that the Rail Authority has granted approval
- any other relevant information, including a contact email address.

#### **IMPORTANT!**

Even if you do not need a stock permit because you are not using the roads listed in the bylaw, you must still comply with the bylaw's conditions.

**ENROL NOW FOR THE MALVERN** WARD BY-ELECTION

If you live in the Malvern Ward of the Selwyn District you should to take action now to enrol to vote or check that your enrolment details are correct for the by-election to be held on 7 August 2009.

Have you moved house or changed your name or other details? To vote in the byelection, you will need to enrol or update your enrolment details by 18 June.

This is important, because you will receive voting papers in the mail and be able to have a say in the election **only** if you are correctly enrolled. If you are a newly-eligible voter you should enrol as soon as possible; if you are already enrolled, check that your enrolment details are up to date.

Voters enrolled on the General and Maori electoral rolls are eligible to vote in the by-election, which will be held by postal



Helpline is a personalised service where you can call us or use our website to report issues, and let us know of your concerns that the council should be aware of.


