

#### It's All About Seatbelts – They Save Lives!

Police are extremely concerned about the number of people who do not wear seatbelts in cars. Sergeant Warren Campbell states that in 2007 eight lives could have been saved on Selwyn roads if people had been wearing seatbelts, but that some Selwyn drivers, mostly males, still fail to wear them.



Last week Sergeant Campbell spent 90 minutes in Darfield, during which time he issued six failure-to-wear-seatbelt notices. He cannot stress enough the importance of wearing

> a seatbelt, which prevents a traveller from being smacked at full speed into a windscreen, dashboard, seat back or fellow passenger.

> Is it true that the aliens are coming back to Selwyn to help the Police and Road Safety target seatbelts in Selwyn? Watch this space!

> Wearing a seatbelt increases your chances of surviving a crash by 40% - and greatly reduces your risk of broken bones, brain damage or disfigurement, so I cannot understand why anyone would choose not to

wear such a basic safety device. Some of the excuses I've heard include:

- My seatbelt is uncomfortable.
- I'm only going to the shops, 5 minutes away.
- My car is as safe as houses.
