RECYCLING MATTERS

Selwyn's recycling households really excelled themselves for their first wheelie bin recycling collection, putting out 99.9 tonnes, compared to the previous week's 32.3 tonnes. We thought that the extra 67 tonnes might have come from the landfill-bound rubbish collection. Alas no. The rubbish tonnage barely changed, from 130.5 to 128.8 tonnes. So there's a challenge for the weeks ahead.

Divert that rubbish

I know that it takes an effort, but if you recycle all you can, and compost your organic waste, either at home or through the Council's organic collection, you will have very little left to put in the rubbish collection. You can then save dollars by downsizing your rubbish container. So let's see if we can bring that rubbish tonnage down by putting the plastics, glass, metals and paper into the yellow-top bin rather than a bag or rubbish wheelie-bin..

Grate deliveries

Manufacturing delays held up the delivery of black crates to some off-route properties, mainly those using the Monday collection. The new crates have now arrived and deliveries of second crates to off-route properties should be completed this week.
