


Agency and a number of community appointees. As part of the strategy development, the Committee will identify challenges facing our transport system over the next 30

## **DRAFT PLAN CHANGE 15**

The Council has begun consultation on **Draft Plan Change 15 – Lincoln Retail Distribution**, to ensure that the District Plan sustainably manages the distribution of retail activity in Lincoln township. In particular, the draft plan change is designed to ensure that significant adverse distributional effects on the Lincoln town centre are avoided, while also providing for a range of retail activities to be established in the township to meet the needs of the community.

Consultation on the current draft plan will be in two stages. We are seeking comments on the proposed amendments to the District Plan, and the consultation period on the draft plan change will be open until **5pm Friday 27 November 2009.** 

Following the consultation period, Council staff will consider the comments received, make changes to the draft Plan Change if required, and seek Council approval of the Plan Change to proceed to formally notify it in accordance with the requirements of the Resource Management Act. Once the approved plan change is formally notified, anyone may submit written supporting or opposing arguments. A Council hearing will be held to consider submissions on the Plan Change.
