DOG MICROCHIPPING

If your dog was first registered after **30 June 2006** and is not a working dog, the law requires him or her to be microchipped. This free monthly service is available at the following Council service centres:

	Leeston	Rolleston	Darfield
	10.30-11am	1-2 pm	9-9.30am

Please note:

- No Lincoln clinic this month and Leeston and Darfield will only be for 30 minutes.
- Rolleston microchipping is at the council offices in Norman Kirk Drive (off Rolleston Drive).
- Microchipping will not take place if wet.
- Working dogs and dogs registered before 1 July 2006 can be microchipped for \$20 per dog.

If, because of distance or dog numbers, you can't get to a clinic, you can ask for an **Animal Control Officer** to carry out the microchipping at your place. Contact **Tracey Wheeler** on 347 2800 or 318 8338.

DOGS CAN'T HELP IT

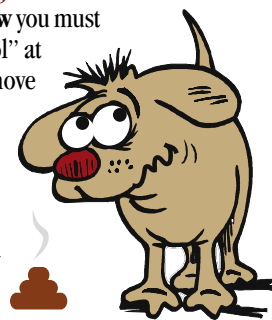
So YOU must clean up after them
