The NZ Transport Agency is now seeking community feedback on the proposed construction of the second stage of the Christchurch Southern Motorway.

This involves building a **four-lane highway from Halswell Junction Road** (connection to Stage 1 of the Christchurch Southern Motorway) to connect with State Highway 1 near **Robinsons Road** south of Christchurch.

Feedback is also wanted on the proposed four-laning of State Highway 1 from Robinsons Road to Rolleston.

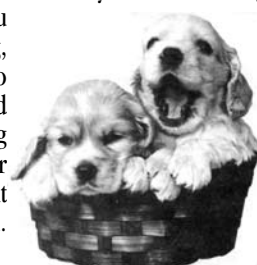

LOST YOUR FAMILY PET OR SEEKING A NEW ONE?

Our policy states that all unclaimed impounded dogs must be held for 7 days before being re-homed. So, if you are looking for a dog, check our website to see who's in the pound this week. Your missing best friend – or your next new one – might just be waiting for you.



If your dog was first registered after **30 June 2006** and is not a working dog, the law requires him or her to be microchipped. This free monthly service is available at the following places.

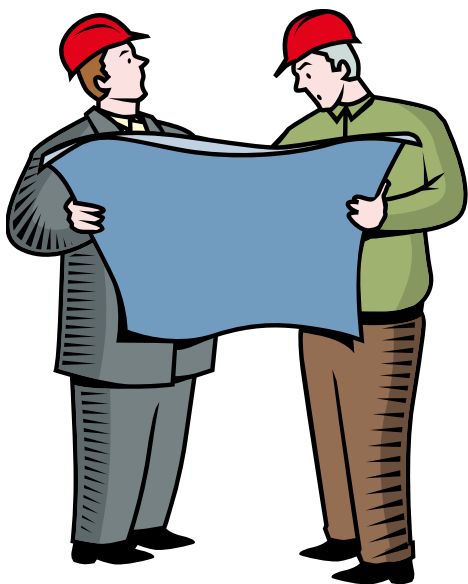
