MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE TRIENNIAL ELECTIONS AND ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS

We encourage residents and ratepayers to get involved with their township advisory committees and the committees which run their reserves and community centres.

Who can stand for election?

Anyone can stand who lives in, or pays rates in, the Selwyn District, or is on the Selwyn electoral roll. For example, if you live in Christchurch but own land in Selwyn, you can stand for nomination.

Who can move or second nominations?

Only those who live in, or pay rates in, the committee's local rating area may move or second a nomination. In other words, only locals can choose who to nominate.

Who can vote?

Anyone can vote who lives in, or pays rates in, the committee's rating area, or is on the electoral roll in that area.

We now have more options for getting from A to B in Selwyn. The official launch of the Selwyn Star was held at Selwyn District Council Headquarters on Friday, 5 November. Due to the delay of the new branded buses, Rolleston School children have designed an awesome piece of artwork to go on the side of one of the temporary buses.



Selwyn Star provides:

- An improved bus service between Rolleston, Lincoln and the city.
- An improved No. 81 Lincoln service, which will now run every half hour on Saturdays.
- A new No. 88 Rolleston service, which will travel all the way to the city Bus Exchange every 30 minutes, six days a week, and hourly on Sundays.
- A new No. 820 Burnham to Lincoln service that connects Burnham, Rolleston, Springston and Lincoln, running every hour, six days a week, and every two hours on Sundays.

Even more fantastic news: a new fare structure has just been approved by Environment Canterbury. The cost will compare even more favourably with the cost of running a car!!

EXERCISE BENEFIT WITHOUT THE SWEAT

Are you:

- Between the ages of 45 and 65?
- Doing less than 30 minutes of planned physical activity per week?
- Generally healthy?
- Going to be available between 1 Dec and 14 Dec?

If you answered 'yes' to all of these questions, then you could be eligible to participate in a study of the health benefits associated with reduced oxygen. This project has Lincoln University Human Ethics Committee approval.

What's involved

First, you'll be informed about the research. Then, if you decide to participate, your health and fitness will be checked. You will then visit Lincoln University four times a week, for four weeks. After this, your fitness will be tested again. That's it!

SHARE THE ROAD

It's great to see so many cyclists out on our roads, and so many wearing fluoro safety vests. It's a brave soul who doesn't. Many of Selwyn's 100km per hour narrow roads don't lend themselves to safe cycling, so pedallers need to be as visible as possible.

And yes drivers, cycles have just as much right on the road as cars. Cars and bikes need to share the roadway, respect each other's space, be alert to each other's needs and stick to basic road rules and etiquette.

"Share the road" for cyclist's means:

- being visible, with lights, reflectors and bright clothing
- obeying road rules
- avoiding sudden changes of direction
- cycling in single file, not 2 or 3 abreast

For drivers, "share the road" means:

- keeping a sharp eye out for bicycles at all times
- double-checking for cyclists when turning left or opening car doors
- using indicators when turning, even if no other cars are behind you, just in case a cyclist is there
- giving cyclists plenty of "safe space" when passing.


