#### Who may stand for election?

Anyone can stand who lives in, or pays rates in, the Selwyn District, or is on the Selwyn electoral roll. For example, if you live in Christchurch but own land in Selwyn, you can stand for nomination.

#### Who may move or second nominations?

Only those who live in, or pay rates in, the committee's local rating area may move or second a nomination. In other words, only locals can choose whom to nominate

#### Who may vote?

Anyone can vote who lives in, or pays rates in, the committee's rating area, or is on the electoral roll in that area

### Burn Now Before Summer Heats Up

The burning of tyres, plastics and treated wood is not allowed anywhere or anytime under Environment Canterbury's Air Plan.



you may burn **crop residue**, **vegetation**, **paper**, **cardboard** and **untreated wood**.

Where possible, we prefer you to recycle or compost these items but, if burning is your only

But, if you live on the plains in non-residential areas,

compost these items but, if burning is your only option, do it now before the district heats up and fire restrictions come in.

If you live in hill and high country areas you must first get a fire permit from the Selwyn District Council before burning.

**If you live in residential areas** you must first get a resource consent from Environment Canterbury before burning – phone (03) 365 6828.

Because fire or hot embers can easily spread into hedges, buildings and vegetation, you should **never leave a fire unattended**. If you cannot watch the fire yourself, get someone to do it for you.

Also, some fires can burn or smoulder for days. Don't get caught out! When you have finished burning, douse the ashes with plenty of water.
