Who may stand for election?

Anyone can stand who lives in, or pays rates in, the Selwyn District, or is on the Selwyn electoral roll. For example, if you live in Christchurch but own land in Selwyn, you can stand for nomination.

Who may move or second nominations?

Only those who live in, or pay rates in, the committee's local rating area may move or second a nomination. In other words, only locals can choose whom to

Who may vote?

Anyone can vote who lives in, or pays rates in, the committee's rating area, or is on the electoral roll



For Selwyn residents facing the stress of rebuilding or repairing their homes and recovering their livelihoods after the Canterbury Earthquake, it is sometimes difficult to know who can help.

Jenny can tell you exactly who to get in touch with to help or can even contact them on your behalf.

Other people to call if you need assistance, support or advice include:

- The Quake Support and Counselling Service (0800 777 846, 9am to 11pm seven days a week) helps those who are not coping or need support.
- The Earthquake Government Helpline (0800 779 997, 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday) gives information and advice on income support, housing options, health issues, community assistance, Civil Defence or any other government service.
- The Selwyn District Council Helpline (03 347 2800 or 03 318 8338) can offer information on a range of earthquake related matters, and if they can not answer your question they can put you in touch with someone that can.
