Applications close on Thursday 30 June 2011

Applications to the Council's Heritage Fund are now open for the 2011 round of grants. These grants help to meet some of the extra costs associated with protecting heritage buildings and trees for the community's benefit.

The fund is open to owners of heritage buildings or protected trees within the Selwyn District (preference is given to those items listed in the Selwyn District Plan or with NZHPT).

Grants given in other years have been around \$500-\$2,500, depending on the work being done (e.g. fireplace restoration, brickwork replacement, building restoration and heritage enhancement).

For your project, you will need to include at least two quotes from tradespeople with the right knowledge and experience to carry out the work, so don't leave your application until the last minute.



participated in our phone survey so far. Some of you have wondered why we ask about age, religion, ethnicity, employment and so on. The aim is not to find out about you personally, but about the sample as a whole.

To get good statistical data for better decisionmaking it's necessary to know that the people doing the survey are a fair reflection of the general population of Selwyn. The only way to do this is to compare our sample with the 2006 census data for the district.

That means comparing religion, ethnicity, sex, age, location and occupation. If our sample and the census have similar

percentages in most of these different categories then the sample is likely to be fairly representative.

So please answer these questions as you would normally answer them in the census. Consider it a rehearsal for next year (and remember that the survey is also

anonymous).

Do you need to build temporary accommodation or business facilities due to earthquake damage?

If so, the please check the Council requirements before doing so.

The Canterbury Earthquake (Resource Management Act Permitted Activities) Order 2011 (Permitted Activities OIC) came into force on 22 February 2011.

Under this Order in Council, temporary residential and business activities (including storage facilities) are permitted if they are required owing to the September 2010 earthquake (and aftershocks). These must be located in an area specified for this purpose.

- Temporary Family Flats
- Temporary Business Accommodation and Temporary Depots and Storage Facilities
- Residing in Earthquake Damaged Dwelling while Constructing a New Dwelling
