

## DOG REGISTRATION STARTS IN JULY!

It's that time of year again when all dog owners must ensure that their

dogs are registered. The penalties for non-registration can be expensive. All dogs older than three months must be registered every year (July-June) as per the Dog Control Act 1996.

The re-registration notice will not arrive in your letterbox until 1 July or just after.

**Registration Fee** (Inclusive of GST)

The 2011-12 fee falls due on 1 July 2011 and may be paid throughout the month of July. This may be done at the Rolleston Headquarters or the service centres in Leeston, Darfield, Lincoln or Rolleston Library. Alternatively, you may use the prepaid return envelope provided with your registration form or use telebanking/internet banking. If paid by 31 July **2011**, the registration fee applicable is:

- \$35.00 for the first dog
- \$25.00 for each additional dog owned by the same person and held at the same locality

Payment after 31 July 2011 will incur a penalty and the registration fee applicable is:

- \$50.00 for the first dog
- \$35.00 for each additional dog owned by the same person and held at the same locality

## **Change of Address**

If you have changed address since last year's registration, please contact this office so that your details can be confirmed.

## **Tag and Collar Fees** (Inclusive of GST)

The fee for a replacement dog tag is \$5.00 and for a dog collar 6.00 - 8.00 depending on the

#### **Seizure Fee** (Inclusive of GST)

If the Council's Animal Control Officers seize a wandering dog, and the dog can be readily identified by its current registration tag, then the officer has the discretion to charge the owner a seizure fee of \$46.00 upon return of the dog to the owner.

## **Impoundment Fees** (Inclusive of GST)

If the Council's Animal Control Officers impound your dog, the following fees will apply:

- \$46.00 for the first impoundment
- \$69.00 for the second
- \$138.00 for the third

You will also be charged as follows:

- an administration fee of \$11.50 per impounding
- a sustenance fee of \$33.20 per dog per day or part thereof
- officer's travel time \$50.00 (flat fee)
- (where applicable) a destruction fee of \$11.25 (These fees and charges are set under Sections 37, 38 and 68 of the Dog Control Act 1996.)

## Upcoming forum on changes to the Building Code for Canterbury

The Department of Building and Housing (DBH) has made changes to the Building Code to increase the seismic hazard factor for Canterbury and to require stronger foundations for buildings.

Builders, architects, engineers, merchants and designers need to be aware of the changes, especially as they have already taken effect.

In the first instance, they should visit www.dbh.govt.nz and review the B1 Structure section of the Building Code, and make sure they understand all the changes.

If they have any questions about what the changes mean for building consents – either recently issued consents or future ones – they should contact the Selwyn District Council's building team on 347 2839.
