
Denise Sheat, who has had a long involvement with the Ngati Moki Marae at Taumutu and has lectured in Maori Studies, will speak on the history of the lake.

Proposed Plan Change 26 - Rakaia Huts Wāhi Taonga Management Areas and Sites

Council has developed Proposed Plan Change 26 to the Selwyn District Plan.

Plan Change 26 implements methods to manage threats to cultural and archaeological values identified in the Rakaia Huts Conservation Management Plan, which was adopted by Council in October 2009.

The Plan Change is concerned with the culture and heritage provisions of the District Plan which relate specifically to $W\overline{a}hi$ Taonga Management Areas and Sites in and around Rakaia Huts Township.

Further submissions can now be made on Plan Change 26.


Ellesmere Water Race Shutdown

On behalf of the Selwyn District Council, Glenroy Community Irrigation Co. Ltd are temporarily shutting off the Upper Ellesmere water race intake and scheme to allow for intake maintenance.

The intake will be **closed on 23 August** and will be **reopened on 25 August**. Races affected include Rakaia Tce, Sharlands, Waikimihia, Rakaia, Selwyn and Illingworth Roads and all

offshoots. Flow may take time to reach all downstream users of the scheme.
