Ward Discretionary Fund

Are you wondering why your rubbish/recycling or organics is not being collected?

Make sure you put your rubbish bags/crates or wheelie bins out by 7.30am.

If you use bags, **only use** official Selwyn District Council white rubbish bags, which you can purchase from your local supermarket or Council service centre/library.

Supermarket shopping bags, other bags, non-Selwyn District Council crates, and beer boxes with empties will **not** be collected

You can drop off your recycling, organics and rubbish (including mattresses, electrical goods, paint, gas bottles etc) at the **Pines Resource Recovery Park** on Burnham School Rd, from 9am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday, plus Saturday and Sunday from 1pm to 4pm. Phone (03) 347 2026.

Septic tanks and connecting to town sewer schemes

Rural checks on septic tanks around Selwyn District have now been completed. Pictured is a diagram illustrating the normal operating level for a septic tank. If yours differs from this picture, you'll need to get it checked by a registered drainlayer.

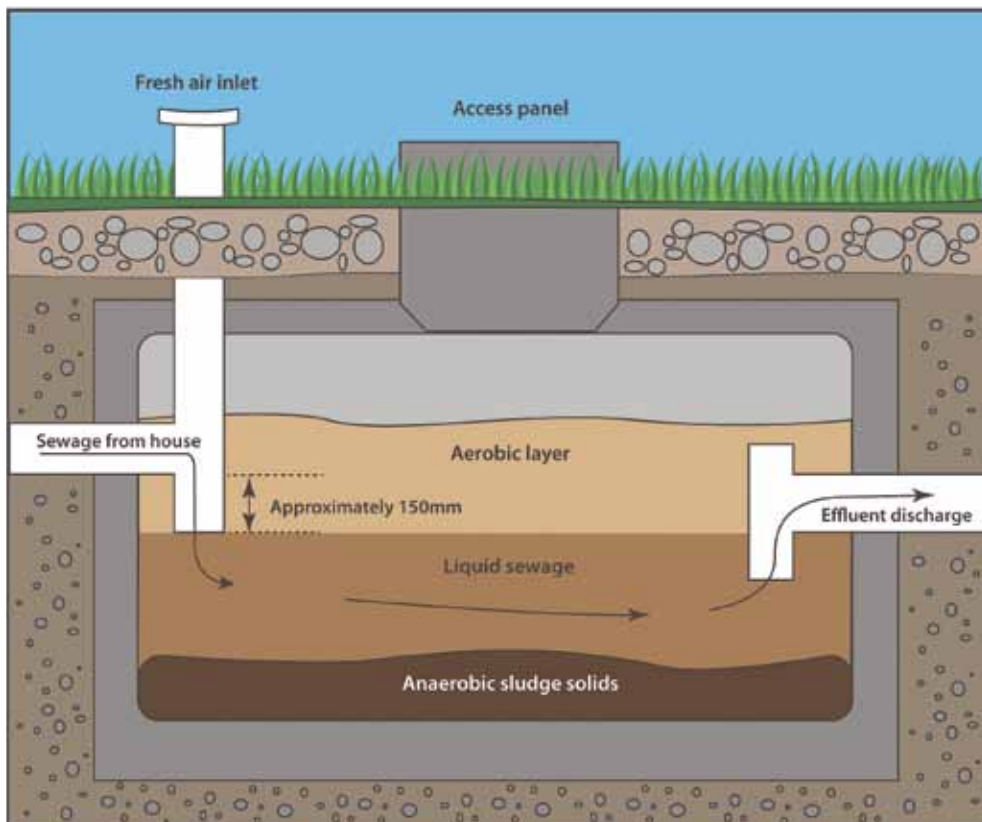
The earthquakes have caused damage to septic tanks and disposal systems around the district, and it's worth talking to EQC to see whether your claim will cover repairs.

Some residents have a requirement to connect to their town sewer schemes by November next year. Late last year the council contacted those property owners who were recorded as yet to connect to the piped sewer system, outlining the time-frame for connections.

A second letter is about to be sent out to remind people that their properties now have just over 12 months left to be connected. Council is encouraging people to make contact so some guidance can be offered about how to go about connecting.

"We're keen to meet our deadline of having the outstanding 250 properties connected by 1 November 2012," Mr Wild says. "Please do not leave it until the last minute. And remember to obtain building consents before doing any physical drainage work."

Revised development contributions public meeting

A public meeting to discuss the proposed revision of development contributions for the **Eastern Selwyn Sewerage Scheme** will take place on Tuesday, 20 September at 7.30pm in the Council Chamber, Norman Kirk Drive, Rolleston. All are welcome. Submission hearings will be held in the Council Chamber on Wednesday 5 October at 4pm and Thursday 6 October at 5pm.

Fonterra Resource Consent Application

Because of their possible environmental effects, many activities need a resource consent from the Council. Any person has the right to inspect the full consent application at any Council Service Centre or view on the council website www.selwyn.govt.nz and make a submission supporting or opposing the proposal. A trade competitor may make a submission, but only regarding an effect of the proposed activity that (a) adversely affects the environment and (b) does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.

Malvern Ward

Fonterra Co-operative Group Ltd (Application 115199) seeks to undertake a 10 year resource consent to expand construction and operations at the Darfield Milk Powder Plant. The proposed Stage 2 expansion will involve the construction of a second dryer up to 56 metres high with two stacks 7 metres above this, a second boiler and ash collection facility, expansion of the dry store by 30,000 sq m, additional earthworks exceeding 5000 sq m, an additional 393 vehicle movements per day including an additional 295 heavy vehicle movements, a seven day a week / 24 hour rail operation, an additional 23 on site staff and 39 tanker drivers, additional signage, storage of hazardous substances and generation of solid waste exceeding the levels permitted in the Partially Operative District Plan.

The land is on 680 hectares adjacent to S.H.73, near Racecourse Hill, 3.5 km north-west of Darfield.
