PUBLIC NOTICE ON ELECTORAL SYSTEM AND RIGHT TO DEMAND A POLL

Notice is given under Section 28 (i) of the Local Electoral Act 2001, that the electors of the Selwyn District Council have the right to demand a poll as to which electoral system should be used for Council and Community Board elections. The current electoral system used is the First Past the Post (FPP) electoral system.

A valid demand must be:

- Made in writing
- Signed by at least 5% of the number of electors enrolled as eligible to vote at the previous triennial general election of the Selwyn District Council. This will require 1345 valid signatures
- Delivered to the office of the Selwyn District Council, 2 Norman Kirk Drive, Rolleston by 18 December 2011.

Every elector who signs a demand must also set out in that demand his or her full name and the address for which he or she is qualified as an elector of the Selwyn District Council.
