

Burn now before summer heats up

Now is a good time to clear your rural properties before the summer heats up and fire restrictions are in place.

Property owners on the plains can currently burn without a fire permit but those in the hill and high country will need a fire permit from the Selwyn District Council.

For those living in residential areas, burning is prohibited unless resource consent has been obtained from Environment Canterbury.

If you are burning it is important to never leave a fire unattended as an unpredictable wind can change conditions quickly. If you cannot do this yourself, you must arrange for someone to do this for you. Depending on the size of the pile and material being burned, the fire could burn for several days.

Ashes fanned by strong winds can reignite fires and spread hot embers into adjoining hedges, buildings and vegetation causing wild fires which result in extensive damage and costs.

Don't get caught out! Do not leave fires unattended and when you have finished burning, cool the hot ashes with plenty of water.
