Selwyn Mayor Kelvin Coe and Cr Nigel Barnett officially opened the reserve on Sunday by planting a tree.

When people visit the reserve, because it is a "work in progress", sturdy footwear is needed and people should keep to the tracks and open grassed area. If picnicking, people need their own water supplies and dogs must be under effective control. The lake water is not safe for swimming or drinking for people or dogs.

The reserve is signposted on the Southbridge-Leeston Road in the area of the Catholic Cemetery.

#### **Outdoor burning banned in** residential areas

As summer heats up and outdoor activities are more prevalent, residents need to remember that outdoor fires are banned in all residential areas throughout Selwyn district.

and can be a health hazard. It can also contribute to air pollution.

Along with a ban on burning in Selwyn's residential area there is also a restriction in place for burning within 100 metres of residential areas and what Environment Canterbury calls 'sensitive' areas, for example schools, hospitals and parks.

Currently there are no restrictions on burning within Selwyn's rural areas on the plains providing you are not in the residential areas and outside the 100 metre zone for 'sensitive' areas. There are, however, rules around the wind direction which could cause smoke from the fire to become a nuisance to neighbours.

Residents are reminded that there is a permanent restricted fire season applying to the hill and high country areas of Selwyn District.
