Selwyn's ground zoning and consequent remedial requirements for foundations have not changed since December 2010 when Ian McCahon's geotech report on the district was released.

Selwyn residents wanting building consent who are on rural residential sites where no land remediation is likely to take place should get site specific geotech investigations of the land; and engineer's reports outlining any specific designs for foundations. Nothing for Selwyn residents has changed in terms of proceeding with building since December 2010, but getting the right documents will help speed up the process.


