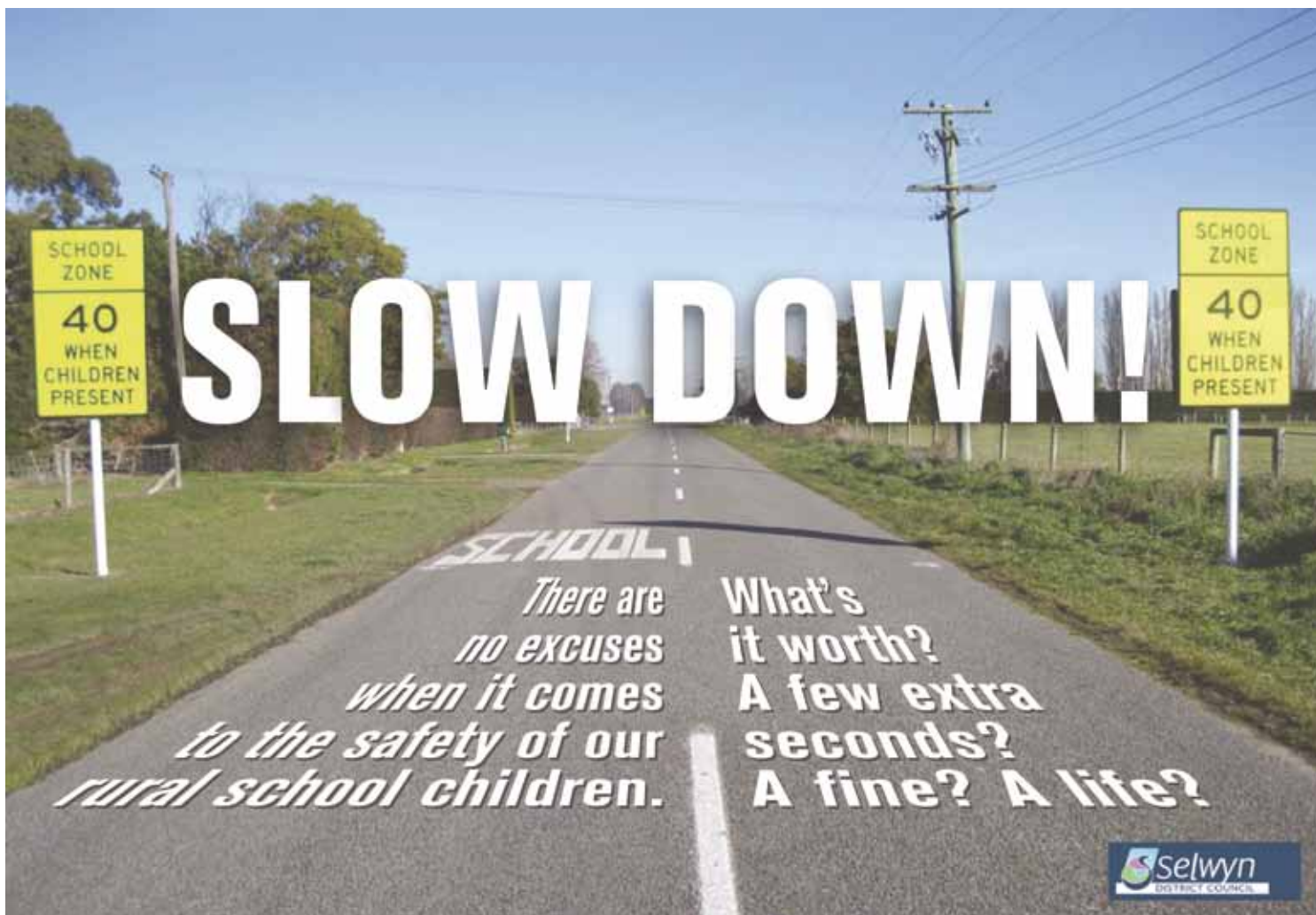


## In use 20 August

### Ellesmere Water Race Shutdown

On behalf of the Selwyn District Council, **Glenroy Community Irrigation Co. Ltd** are temporarily shutting off the Upper Ellesmere water race intake and scheme to allow for intake maintenance.

The intake will be closed on **23rd August** and will be reopened on **25th August**. Races affected include Rakaia Tce, Sharlands, Waikimihia, Rakaia, Selwyn and Illingworth Roads and all off-shoots. Flow may take time to reach all downstream users of the scheme.
