Back to school – watch out!

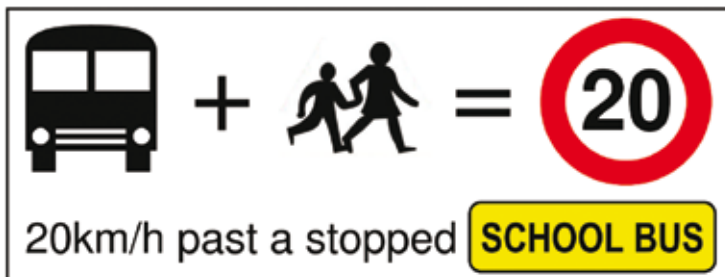
Selwyn District kids are back at school this week.

Drivers always need to take extreme care when passing young cyclists. Give them plenty of space as some are still gaining experience cycling on the road.

Parents should encourage their children to learn how to cycle and also how to check their bike regularly, including brakes, tyres, lights and reflectors.

Ensure your child always wears a cycle helmet. Teach them how to use hand signals when stopping and turning.

Even more children walk and scoot to and from school. Many



of these children are very young and can be unpredictable when out and about near the road.

Drivers need to be alert and watch for children everywhere – sometimes when they're crossing the road they have trouble judging the distance and speed of oncoming traffic.

As a parent, if you walk with your children to school, talk to them about road safety. When

showing them what to look for, get down to their height, as this helps you see what your child sees. Teach them the kerb drill so they may cross the road safely even in places where there are no pedestrian crossings or school patrol.

Historical Society to visit Burnham

Waitangi Day, 6 February

The Ellesmere Historical Society has arranged a visit to the Burnham Military Camp. The tour will



include a number of historic buildings and sites within the camp grounds.

Historic buildings include the Industrial School which was open from 1873 to 1918. A museum is now being developed in the Detention Centre, which was opened in 1910 and used until 1923.

All Saints Church was the first Anglican Church on the plains south of Christchurch when it was built at Ashley Dene in 1864. In 1903 it was shifted by traction engine to Burnham and has been known as the Garrison Church.
