Intersection Layout Change

The intersection of Lincoln Rolleston Road and Selwyn Road will be **closed permanently for vehicles in early April** due to a change to the intersection. The new route is via Weedons Road/Selwyn Road.

Once construction is complete, cycle and pedestrian access will be available.

This upgrade is part of the overall CRETS (Christchurch-Rolleston-Environ Transportation Study) long term transport strategy, creating a secondary route between Christchurch and Rolleston.

Always take another look at intersections

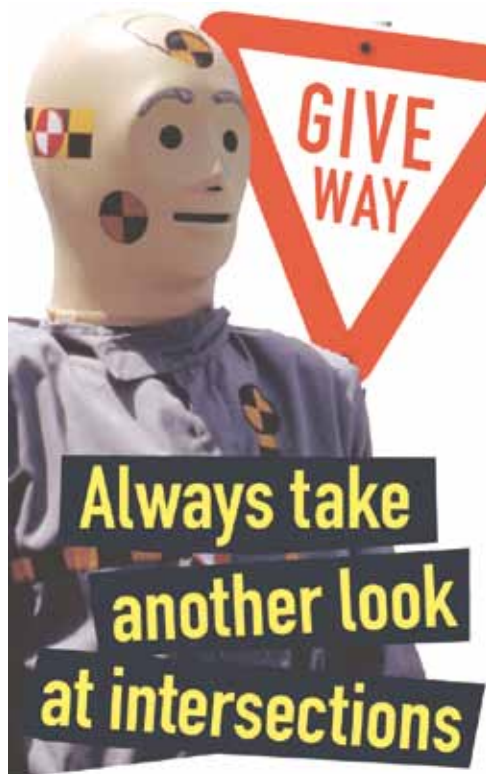
Selwyn's crash test dummies, "Vince" and "Larry" are part of our 2012 Intersection Campaign **"Always take another look at Intersections"**.
