Road Mum's key tips for frosty mornings:

- Look out for shaded areas caused by high banks, tall trees and hedges where roads freeze sooner and ice may not thaw during the day
- Bridges could also stay slippery longer, so slow down when crossing
- Drive slower than you normally would, avoid sudden braking or turning movements that could cause you to skid
- Accelerate smoothly and brake gently
- Make sure your windscreen is clear before setting off, which reminds me, look out for the free windscreen cloths which will be in the Council Library/ Service Centres after Queen's Birthday Weekend.

PROPOSED ROAD STOPPING – PART OF TWO CHAIN ROAD BETWEEN HIGHFIELD ROAD AND COALTRACK ROAD NORWOOD

Council have been asked to formally stop part of an unformed road known as **Two Chain Road** between Highfield Road and Coaltrack Road, Norwood containing 3.0110 hectares in area so that it may be purchased and incorporated into adjacent land. The land is described as Sections 1 & 2 on Survey Office Plan 448714.

Selwyn District is one of the fastest growing districts in New Zealand.

We have been planning for this growth for a number of years as a partner in the Greater Christchurch Urban Development Strategy (UDS).

As a result of the Canterbury earthquakes, and subsequent government decisions on red-zoned land in Greater Christchurch, land for housing is a primary consideration for Councils throughout Greater Christchurch.

Council's Plan Change 7 to rezone more than 800 hectares of land for future residential development in 2010 (before the Canterbury earthquakes) is now complete with land rezoned for residential use and available for developers to subdivide to provide sections for the market.

We are working with developers to ensure that subdivision consents are processed as quickly as possible.
