DOG REGISTRATION STARTS IN JULY!



It's that time of year again when all dog owners must ensure that their dogs are registered. The penalties for non-registration can be expensive. All dogs older than three months must be registered every year (July – June) as per the Dog Control Act 1996.

The re-registration notice will not arrive in your letterbox until **1 July** or just after.



Registration Fee (Inclusive of GST)

The 2012/13 fee falls due on **1 July 2012** and may be paid throughout the month of July. This may be done at the Selwyn District Council Rolleston offices or the Leeston, Darfield, Lincoln or Rolleston Library/Service Centres.

Alternatively, you may use the prepaid return envelope provided with your registration form or use telebanking/internet banking.

If paid by **31 July 2012**, the registration fee applicable is:

\$35.00 for the first dog

\$25.00 for each additional dog owned by the same person and held at the same locality.

Payment **after** 31 July 2012 will incur a penalty and the registration fee applicable is:

\$50.00 for the first dog

\$35.00 for each additional dog owned by the same person and held at the same locality.

Change of Address

If you have changed address since last year's registration, please contact this office so that your details can be confirmed.

Tag and Collar Fees (Inclusive of GST)

The fee for a replacement dog tag is \$5.00 and for a dog collar \$6.00 – \$8.00 depending on the size.

(These fees and charges are set under Sections 37, 38 and 68 of the Dog Control Act 1996.)



Sections available in Selwyn

Selwyn District is one of the fastest growing districts in New Zealand.

We have been planning for this growth for a number of years as a partner in the **Greater Christchurch Urban Development Strategy (UDS)**.

As a result of the Canterbury earthquakes, and subsequent government decisions on red-zoned land in Greater Christchurch, land for housing is a primary consideration for Councils throughout Greater Christchurch.

Council's **Plan Change 7** to rezone more than 800 hectares of land for future residential development in 2010 (before the Canterbury earthquakes) is now complete with land rezoned for residential use and available for developers to subdivide to provide sections for the market.

We are working with developers to ensure that subdivision consents are processed as quickly as possible.

Malvern Stockwater Reduced flows

Council will be shutting down the Lower Kowai Intake on **Monday, 11 June** for tunnel maintenance. The shutdown will remain in effect until **26 July** or earlier depending on completion of the work.

The Upper Kowai Intake will remain open, and a reduced flow will be maintained. Properties affected are in the Springfield, Sheffield, Waddington, Darfield, Kirwee and Greendale areas.

My goodness, the snow we had last week was pretty bad. I went to work but had to go home early as it seemed to get heavier as the day went on. Here are a few driving tips for ice and snow:

- Drive **slow** on ice and snow
- Drive with your head lights **on dip** for increased safety
- Consider if you need to travel, especially if the conditions are poor
- Check the weather forecast and road conditions regularly
- Increase following distances, the 2-second rule should be at least the 4-second rule
- Winter maintenance vehicles may be on the roads, obey all instructions and do not pass unless instructed to
- After snow begins to melt, be aware of ice on the roads, especially in shaded places
- Always carry a cell phone, a torch and warm clothing in the car, just in case you get stuck in snow
