DOG REGISTRATION STARTS IN JULY!



again when all dog applicable is: owners must ensure that their dogs are registered. The penalties for non-registration can be expensive. All dogs

older than three months must be registered every year (July – June) as per the Dog Control Act 1996.

The re-registration notice will not arrive in your letterbox until 1 July or just after.



Registration Fee (Inclusive of GST)

The 2012/13 fee falls due on 1 July 2012 and may be paid throughout the month of July. This may be done at the Selwyn District Council Rolleston offices or the Leeston, Darfield, Lincoln or Rolleston Library/Service Centres.

Alternatively, you may use the prepaid return envelope provided with your registration form or use telebanking/internet banking.

It's that time of year If paid by 31 July 2012, the registration fee

\$35.00 for the first dog

\$25.00 for each additional dog owned by the same person and held at the same locality.

Payment after 31 July 2012 will incur a penalty and the registration fee applicable is:

\$50.00 for the first dog

\$35.00 for each additional dog owned by the same person and held at the same locality.

Change of Address

If you have changed address since last year's registration, please contact this office so that your details can be confirmed.

Tag and Collar Fees (Inclusive of GST)

The fee for a replacement dog tag is \$5.00 and for a dog collar \$6.00 - \$8.00depending on the size.

(These fees and charges are set under Sections 37, 38 and 68 of the Dog Control Act 1996.)



Leading Learners

ON THE ROAD TO BETTER DRIVING



This informative hands-on driver training day is delivered by a team of driving instructors and is offered to Selwyn district secondary students who have held a learner licence for at least six months, along with a

parent or caregiver.

The course has proven successful with learners and parents alike, because it teaches them practical skills that other programmes don't — driving on different road surfaces, stopping distances, hazards, distraction and dealing with peer pressure. The aim is to help learners prepare for getting their restricted licence and driving alone.

This course is subsidised by the New Zealand Transport Agency and Selwyn District Council, making the cost just \$20 per learner.

In order to provide high quality training, spaces on the course are limited.

Sun-strike can occur at any time, but is most likely during sunrise or sunset during the winter months, when the sun's rays hit your windscreen at a low angle. This can make it difficult, or even impossible, to see.


If you drive the same road regularly at these times of day, watch out for the common areas where sun-strike could affect your ability to see both oncoming traffic and the road ahead. This is a very dangerous condition to drive in.

- Keep your windscreen clean, inside and out
