Recently, I heard from one of our local residents, that she has experienced confusion at the intersection of Walkers Road and Dunns Crossing Road where they meet at State Highway 1. It is controlled by a Give Way sign on one side and a Stop sign on the other.

The vehicle facing the Stop sign must allow all other traffic to proceed first, regardless of whether the vehicle on the Give Way sign is turning right, left or continuing straight ahead.
