Still very frosty and icy in the morning isn't it?

Always allow an extra five minutes in the morning to start your vehicle and defrost windscreens and windows before setting off.

Remember, frost is more severe at **daybreak** so be prepared for this after it becomes light. It may not be frosty or icy at 6am, but could well be an hour or two later.

Road Mum's key tips for frosty mornings:

- Look out for shaded areas caused by high banks, tall trees and hedges where roads freeze sooner and ice may not thaw during the day
- Bridges could also stay slippery longer, so slow down when crossing
- Drive slower than you normally would, avoid sudden braking or turning movements that could cause you to skid
- Accelerate smoothly and brake gently

Last few days for submissions on new dog rules

Council has undertaken a review of the 2006 Dog Control Bylaw because of legislative requirements and it made sense to concurrently review the Council's Policy on Dogs.

Proposed changes identified by a working party set up to review the rules include a requirement that people with a dog in a public place must carry a container for removal of dog faeces, and that Council might in future allow dogs off-leash on reserves when they are not in use for sports or organised events.

Written submissions must be received at the Selwyn District Council by **Friday, 3 August.**

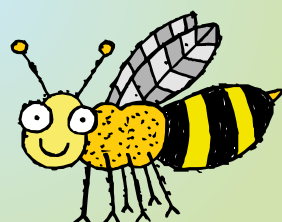


Weed-spraying in Rolleston

Council contractor SICON intends to hand-spray Mavrik Aquaflow, a synthetic pyrethroid, on a few isolated plants in Ambrose Reserve, Rolleston because of a thrips infestation.

"**Horticultural spraying in progress**" signage will advise the public when spraying is taking place. The spraying will take place weekly for four weeks when weather conditions are calm, probably starting later this week.

Information about the spray indicates the dried residue of the spray is non-toxic and non-repellent to foraging bees.
