Ellesmere Water Race Shutdown

On behalf of the Selwyn District Council, Glenroy Community Irrigation Co. Ltd are temporarily shutting off the Upper Ellesmere water race intake and scheme to allow for intake maintenance.

The intake will be closed on Tuesday, 28 August and will be reopened on Thursday, 30 August. Races affected include Rakaia Tce, Sharlands, Waikimihia, Rakaia, Selwyn and Illingworth Roads and all off-shoots. Flow may take time to reach all downstream users of the scheme.

Selwyn Rural Water Supply **Boil Water Notice**


