message is the same: watch out – children

Keeping children safe on the journey to and from school is everyone's responsibility, not just the school or the council. Here are some tips on reducing chaos at the school gate:

Slow down around schools

are about!

- Remember "20 is plenty" past a stopped school bus
- Ensure children wear their safety vest for increased visibility
- Where possible, encourage children to walk or wheel to and from school
- Join or start a walking school bus
- If dropping off children by car, ensure you

comply with parking restrictions outside the school

- If your child uses a scooter, remind them to walk it across roads
- The quickest journey to and from school is not necessarily the safest – identify a safe route for your child and travel along it with them so they get to know it

Remember children watch what you do parents are role models and children copy your behaviour, good or bad.

Prohibited Fire Season

A prohibited fire season is in place across Selwyn District.

Under the restrictions no outdoor fires can be lit in the District. The burning of crop stubble is also not allowed. Gas barbeques with a high pressure water source at hand are allowed but not charcoal barbeques.

Fire restrictions were introduced in December, and a prohibited fire season was declared on 26 January to help ensure that the risk of additional fires breaking out is minimised.

During the Prohibited Fire Season, it an offence to light any fires in the open air. The prohibition does not apply to gas barbeques lit on a property serviced by a high pressure water supply.
