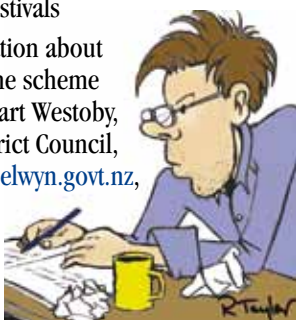
## Are you involved in the arts, but need some financial assistance to make your project work?

### Seventeenth Annual General Meeting

Following the meeting, Ruth Cridge will speak about the VAD and other aspects of her life. The Voluntary Aid Detachment was a branch of the Red Cross. The Ellesmere detachment operated during the Second World War from 1940 to 1945. In many ways it was similar to the Home Guard, but while the Home Guard aimed at defence if there was an invasion, the VAD concentrated on possible nursing needs.





Applications are being invited from Selwyn residents (or people living or working in Selwyn) for the 2013 Gansu International Fellowship Programme.

The programme allows one Selwyn resident to visit the city of Lanzhou in the Gansu Province of China to learn Chinese and be immersed in the local culture for several weeks.

Travel and accommodation costs are covered through the programme. The fellowship recipient will also have the opportunity to visit Gansu's major facilities and tourist attractions.

Shandan, in Gansu Province, is a sister city of Selwyn District. The province is located in North West China and has a population of over 26 million. Much of Gansu's economy is based on mining as the province has significant deposits

of nickel, coal, copper, iron, limestone, crude oil, zinc and other metals. Other important industries include electricity generation, petrochemicals and developing oil exploration machinery.

Applications from people with a wide range of backgrounds will be considered – including business, farming, academic and from students. Applicants should be under 45 years old, in good health, be a University graduate and be willing to present information about Selwyn District.

Applications close 23 May 2013, and should include a CV, an application form, and a letter of recommendation on a prescribed form which is available by emailing [bernadette.ryan@selwyn.govt.nz](mailto:bernadette.ryan@selwyn.govt.nz).

## Precautionary Boil Water Notice: Rolleston Water Supply

Residents who are on the Rolleston Water Supply including the IZONE Business Park are advised to immediately begin boiling water.

A precautionary boil water notice has been issued by Selwyn District Council after test results received on Sunday 12 May showed that E.coli levels were above recommended levels in one of the Council's deep bores. E.coli is an organism which can cause health issues. People are advised to visit their doctors if they are showing any symptoms of sickness, including vomiting and diarrhoea.

The affected well which showed a higher than recommended E.coli count has been switched off from the main Rolleston water supply to prevent further contamination and the Council has begun chlorinating the water supply.

The council will continue to monitor all bores and the reticulation system and keep residents informed.

As at 13 May, one other Boil Water Notice was in place in Selwyn District for the Sheffield water supply. This notice may soon be lifted (check [www.selwyn.govt.nz](http://www.selwyn.govt.nz) for updates).

**No other boil water notices are in place in Selwyn and water from other Council supplies is safe to drink.**

## Darfield Intersection Upgrade

The realignment of Telegraph Road with Bray Street in Darfield has started. Motorists should take extreme care when proceeding through this intersection while this work is being completed. When the realignment has finished the priority at the intersection will change giving right of way to traffic on Bray Street/Telegraph Road. Cardale Street will be controlled by a compulsory stop sign.
