Get the right bin to reduce cost

Do you know how much you are spending on your rubbish and recycling collections?

You could be spending too much, especially if your rubbish wheelie bin is not full every

You could save money and reduce waste going to landfill by switching to a smaller

Costs for kerbside collection are as follows:

1. Rubbish

a. 240 litre wheelie bin \$383 per year b. 80 litre wheelie bin \$117 per year \$1.70 each c. 60 litre bag

2. Recycling

a. 240 litre wheelie bin \$61 per year b. 140 litre wheelie bin \$61 per year \$61 per year c. Two 60 litre crates

3. Organics

a. 240 litre wheelie bin \$204 per year

If you put a lot of green waste into your 240 litre rubbish bin you may be better off having an 80 litre rubbish bin and an organics bin.

This would also help reduce green waste going to the landfill. If you would like to change your bin size now is the time.

Precautionary Boil Water Notice: Rolleston Water Supply

Residents who are on the Rolleston Water Supply including the IZONE Business Park are advised to immediately begin boiling water.

A precautionary boil water notice has been issued by Selwyn District Council after test results received on Sunday 12 May showed that E.coli levels were above recommended levels in one of the Council's deep bores.

E.coli is an organism which can cause health issues. People are advised to visit their doctors if they are showing any symptoms of sickness, including vomiting and diarrhoea.

The affected well which showed a higher than recommended E.coli count has been switched off from the main Rolleston water supply to prevent further contamination and the Council has begun chlorinating the water

The council will continue to monitor all bores and the reticulation system and keep residents informed.

As at 13 May, one other Boil Water Notice was in place in Selwyn District for the Sheffield water supply. This notice may soon be lifted (check www.selwyn.govt.nz for updates).

No other boil water notices are in place in Selwyn and water from other Council supplies is safe to drink.

Darfield Intersection Upgrade

The realignment of Telegraph Road with Bray Street in Darfield has started. Motorists should take extreme care when proceeding through this intersection while this work is being completed. When the realignment has finished the priority at the intersection will change giving right of way to traffic on Bray Street/Telegraph Road. Cardale Street will be controlled by a compulsory stop sign.
