Stay Safe on Icy Roads

Selwyn District is now regularly experiencing frost and ice in the morning. Allow extra time to start your vehicle, clear the windscreen, mirrors and all of the windows before setting off. This will greatly improve your visibility in all directions. Use your lights and encourage others to do so too. When driving on ice you will need to slow down and avoid sudden turning or breaking movements which could cause you to skid.

Watch out for shaded areas of road at all times as ice does not thaw completely in many areas where road and car park areas are shaded by tall trees, hedges and buildings. As the picture shows, even at 3pm, there was still frosty layer on this area of road not far from Rolleston.

We have limited numbers of windscreen cloths and ice scrapers left, but these are going fast. Pick one up from your local Library/Service Centre or contact the Road Safety team at the Council on 03 347 2901.

Because of their possible environmental effects, many activities need a resource consent from the Council.

You have the right to inspect the full consent application received by council at any Council Service Centre during normal office hours or view on the council website www.selwyn.govt.nz and make a submission supporting or opposing the proposal.

Any person may make a submission but a person, who is a trade competitor of the applicant, may do so only if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the application relates that

- adversely affects the environment and
- does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
