Nominations for the above positions open on **Friday 19 July 2013** and must be made on the appropriate nomination paper for each position, available from the Electoral Officer. Completed nomination documents must be received by the Electoral Officer no later than **12 noon on Friday 16 August 2013**. Each nomination must be accompanied by a deposit of \$200 incl GST, payable by eftpos, cash, cheque or on-line banking (see candidate handbook for requirements).

Candidates are encouraged to submit a candidate profile statement and photograph for sending out with voting documents to electors. The requirements for profile statements and photos are set out in a candidate handbook which is available with the nomination papers.

The rules for lodgement of nomination documents (nomination paper, candidate profile, photo, deposit and Conflict of Interest Statement [for DHB candidates only]) have now changed. All documents must now be lodged together. Candidates should refer to the candidate handbook for further details.

## Solid Foundations for Lincoln Library

The new library in Lincoln is progressing well, despite the recent wild weather, and the framework of the building is being put up.

The new 700m<sup>2</sup> facility is being constructed from strong steel portal frames which are being assembled on site. The building has been designed to maximise light which will also help heat the building.

It is being built upon deep piles to make it more earthquake resilient. The project is currently on track to be delivered within budget and open in early 2014.

## Winter is here – use your lights!

Winter causes all sorts of problems with visibility when we are driving, including snow and ice, fog, rain and increased hours of darkness. The Road Code says that you must use your vehicle's headlights from 30 minutes after sunset until 30 minutes before sunrise, and at any other time you can't clearly see a person or vehicle 100 metres away.



Most times it is very obvious when you need your lights on but, outside the guidelines given in the road code, there are a number of other weather conditions where using your lights will increase visibility and safety of all road users.

When there is fog, it is raining, or in places where there is the potential for sunstrike, it can become difficult to see other vehicles. Using your lights on dip is the best measure. A vehicle's park lights are only designed for use when your vehicle has stopped.

Increasing your following distance in these conditions is necessary, and you should also take extra care to check ahead thoroughly before passing, as it will be hard to see other vehicles coming towards you.
