## Candidate Nominations

Nominations for candidates for the role of Mayor, Councillors and Community Board members are invited. Nominations must be received by

**12 noon on Friday 16 August 2013.**

Each candidate must be nominated on the official nomination paper available during normal office hours from the following places:

- Darfield library/ service centre
- Leeston library/ service centre
- Lincoln library/ service centre
- Rolleston Council headquarters, 2 Norman Kirk Drive

The form is also available by phoning the Council on 03 347 2800 or 03 318 8338 and asking for a copy to be posted.

A hardcopy nomination (as opposed to a copy emailed or extracted from the council website) is required as each different nomination type has a different colour to make it easier to process nominations.

If you are considering standing as a candidate, don't leave it until the closing date to submit your application.

"Candidates need to allow time for their applications to be reviewed and their details cross checked against the information on the electoral roll," says Selwyn District Council's Electoral Officer Douglas Marshall.

"There are often technical issues which need to be sorted out before a nomination can be accepted and we strongly advise candidates to submit their nominations a couple of days before the closing date."



## Proposed Road Stopping Part of Road off West Coast Road, Springfield

The Council has been asked to formally stop part of an unformed road off West Coast Road, 6075m<sup>2</sup> in area, so that it may be purchased and incorporated into adjacent land. The land is described as Rural Sec 32872 32534 16732 19178 SEC2 SEC1-6 12 RES 1798.

Details of the proposed road-stopping can be inspected at the Council's Headquarters at 2 Norman Kirk Drive, Rolleston, at the Council's service centres in Darfield, Lincoln or Rolleston or online at [www.selwyn.govt.nz/roadstopping](http://www.selwyn.govt.nz/roadstopping). Anyone opposing the road stopping should submit a written objection to the Council no later than 5pm on 18 September 2013.

Our TV Takeback programme has now ended. In total we collected around 2,700 TVs for recycling.
