Lower Ellesmere Water Race Shutdown

The Council will be shutting down the Lower Rakaia Intake for maintenance.

The intake will be closed off from 5 -10 November. The intake will be turned on again on the afternoon of the 10 November or earlier on the completion of work. All races below Northbank Rd and Knyvetts Rd will be affected. An affected area map is available at www. selwyn.govt.nz.

Changes to intersection controls on Wards Road

From Monday 4 November, stop signs will be installed at the intersections of Wards Road with Sandy Knolls Road and Highfield Road. The new stop signs will replace the Give Way signs that are there now and change the priority at the intersection with Wards Road traffic having priority over Sandy Knolls Road and Highfield Road traffic.

The change of priority and the installation of stop signs are being introduced as the traffic volumes have been growing on Wards Road since this route was sealed to provide a better connection between Malvern and Rolleston. With the increase in traffic, it is important that motorists now observe the change in priority and take the care necessary at these intersections.

Changed intersection layout warning signs are being installed at the intersections to let motorists know that the intersections controls will change soon.



RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT 1991

Because of their possible environmental effects, many activities need a resource consent from the Council. You have the right to inspect the full consent application received by council at any Council Service Centre during normal office hours or view on the council website www. selwyn.govt.nz and make a submission supporting or opposing the proposal. Any person may make a submission but a person, who is a trade competitor of the applicant, may do so only if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the application relates that

- (a) adversely affects the environment and
- (b) does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
