- Hororata


The active sprays that will be used in this programme are Glyphosate for general vegetation control.

The majority of drains to be sprayed will be dry. No drain should be considered safe from chemicals until 30 May 2014.

RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT 1991

Because of their possible environmental effects, many activities need a resource consent from the Council.

You have the right to inspect the full consent application received by council at any Council Service Centre during normal office hours or view on the council website www.selwyn.govt.nz and make a submission supporting or opposing the proposal.

Any person may make a submission but a person, who is a trade competitor of the applicant, may do so only if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the application relates that

- (a) adversely affects the environment and
- (b) does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.

Liquor Licence Special Applications – New Process

If you are holding an event this summer that needs a special licence, make sure to plan ahead and apply as soon as possible.

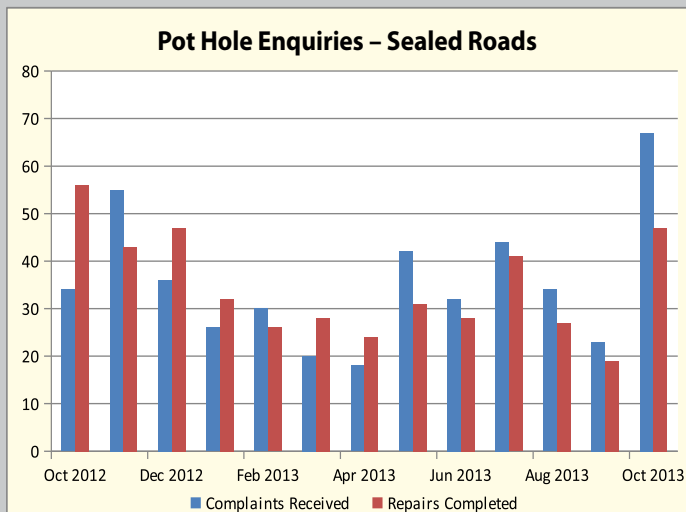
From 18 December this year, the process for getting a special licence will change when the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 comes fully into force. In the past, people have often left it late to apply for a special licence, something that was allowed under the old Sale of Liquor Act.

Under the new law, all applications must be made at least 20 working days before the event is held (although exceptions can be made for unforeseen events, such as funerals). In particular, applications for special Licences for events planned for mid-February 2014 or earlier must be lodged by 18 December.

That's because under the new Act a 'working day' does not include weekends, statutory holidays or any day from 20 December to 15 January inclusive. If you have any questions please contact the District Licensing Office on (03) 365 1667.
