Be Waterwise

Water is a precious resource and we need to use it You can help manage your water carefully. Over summer, demand for water is much consumption wisely by following higher than in winter, as people use more water to these tips: maintain their lawns.

So that there is enough water to go around this summer, we are asking everyone to be careful about how they use water. Some areas like Rolleston also pay for their water based on metered use, so reducing your water consumption will mean you spend less on water bills.



- Water your garden and lawn every few days rather than every
- Water your garden and lawn outside of peak water usage hours (avoid 6am - 9am, and 4pm - 9pm). Watering in the early morning (before 6am) or late evening (after 9pm) will minimise evaporation loss. Also avoid watering in a Nor' West as the water will quickly evaporate
- Using a watering can or hand watering plants by hose uses less water than a sprinkler
- Use a timer to avoid overwatering
- Use mulch or cover the soil with organic matter to keep the soil moist
- When planting choose drought resistant plants that don't require a lot of water
- Wash your car with a bucket of water rather than a hose
- Inspect hoses and taps both indoors and outdoors to check for leaks
- Collect rainwater for use watering gardens and lawns

Liquor Licence Special Applications New Process

If you are holding an event this summer that needs a special licence, make sure to plan ahead and apply as soon as possible.

From 18 December this year, the process for getting a special licence will change when the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 comes fully into force.

In the past, people have often left it late to apply for a special licence, something that was allowed under the old Sale of Liquor Act.

Under the new law, all applications must be made at least 20 working days before the event is held (although exceptions can be made for unforeseen events, such as funerals).

In particular, applications for special Licences for events planned for mid-February 2014 or earlier must be lodged by 18 December.

That's because under the new Act a 'working day' does not include weekends. statutory holidays or any day from 20 December to 15 January inclusive.

Fire training **Exercise - West** Melton

A training exercise for rural fire crews will take place near West Melton on Wednesday 4 December.

The exercise will provide further training for rural fire crews from around the South Island in protecting houses, building and vegetation using fire retardants. The exercise will take place at an ECAN property, just west of the West Melton Firing Range. If conditions are not suitable for the exercise to take place on Wednesday 4 December it will occur on Thursday 5 December.

The exercise will involve crews practising extinguishing a fire by dropping the retardant from a helicopter and a fixed wing aircraft. The exercise will be overseen by the Canterbury Regional Rural Fire Committee and fire fighting crews and resources will be present as well as two Australian experts with experience in this method of fire control.

People in the West Melton area may notice smoke on the day of the exercise coming from the exercise area and aircraft activity at the site.

Safe Burning in Selwyn District

Fire restrictions may be introduced in Selwyn this summer, depending on weather conditions. We are currently in an open fire season. If you need to burn debris from storm damage this is currently permitted in rural areas and now is a good time to do so before conditions become too dry and fire restrictions are imposed.

If restrictions are imposed, burning of this material will not be allowed without a fire permit. Fire permits will only be issued in exceptional circumstances.

What's allowed?

Outdoor fires are not allowed in urban areas, other than gas barbeques, hangis and umus. Currently, in rural areas fires are permitted but you should follow safe burning guidelines. If you are planning to light a fire:

- never do so in high winds or if high winds are forecast
- always have a water source on hand to put out the fire
- have a 10 metre fire break in place around the fire, and
- stay with the fire at all times and dial 111 if it gets out of control

There are a number of other conditions which must be met before fires can be lit – visit selwyn.govt.nz/fire to read these.

Smoke's about

There is an open fire season in Selwyn District so you may see fires in rural areas. Unnecessary fire call outs are expensive and time consuming for volunteer fire fighters to attend. If the fire is supervised, and there is a fire break and water on hand it is probably a controlled operation. However, if there is no one present you should dial 111 to report the fire.


Lincoln Christmas Parade
