MalvernCommunity Board News

At our recent meeting we allocated grants to the Darfield Citizens Advice Bureau to help market and promote their services, and we also allocated funding for Arbor Day tree planting to Darfield, Sheffield, Hororata, Glentunnel, Windwhistle, Kirwee, Springfield and Greendale Primary Schools.

We are hosting our Community Service Awards Evening on Thursday 4 December. This evening will recognise people in the Malvern who have provided outstanding voluntary service to the community.

We also discussed housing needs in Malvern as the Council is gathering information on this currently. We would like to see more options for smaller housing in Malvern – such as units or townhouses and options for older people such as retirement villages. There is also a need for housing for low income families.

We also received an update on McHughs Forest Park and a report on the plan for the park following public consultation will be presented to the Council in the next few weeks.

Proposed Exchange of Part Local Purpose (Gravel) Reserve at Homebush Road, Hororata

Public notice is hereby given in terms of Section 15 of the Reserves Act 1977, of the intention of Selwyn District Council to pass a resolution to exchange a part of its Local Purpose (Gravel) Reserve (known locally as Knowles Pit) situated at 1850 Homebush Road, Hororata and containing 2.0234ha more or less, for an equivalent area of freehold land in the name of the neighbouring farmer.

The exchange will remedy a situation that existed prior to 1985 where the Council extracted gravel from the freehold property. The farmer will receive part of the Council reserve not affected by any metal extraction and Council will receive the area of land from which the metal had been extracted.



PLAN CHANGES 36 AND 41 Prebbleton Living 3 Zones

The Selwyn District Council has accepted the Commissioner's Recommendation to approve with amendments, Plan Changes 36 (Conifer Grove Ltd) and 41 (D&S Anderson).

From the date of this notice the Selwyn District Plan is amended in accordance with these decisions.

Anyone who made a submission on Plan Changes 36 or 41 may appeal to the Environment Court against the Council's decisions. Appeals must be in the prescribed form as set out in Form 7 and must reach the Court within 30 working days of receiving notice of the decision from the Council. A copy of any appeals must also be served on the Council.

Fire Restrictions

A restricted fire season is currently in place in Selwyn district. Under a restricted fire season, only gas barbeques, crop residue and rubbish fires inside contained drums are allowed in rural areas of Selwyn. There are a number of conditions which must be met before fires can be lit – see www.selwyn.govt.nz for information. Any other fires (including bonfires) can only be lit if a permit has been obtained from the Council. If a fire brigade is called to a fire lit in a restricted season which does have a permit or is not allowed under the exemptions, a \$575 callout

In residential areas the only type of fire permitted throughout the year is a gas barbeque. Other fires need a resource consent from Environment Canterbury. In the high country and hill areas of Selwyn, a restricted fire season is permanently in place.


