request to rezone Rural (Outer Plains) land to Living 1 at 134 High Street, Southbridge

Selwyn District Council Clause 5 of the First Schedule, Resource Management Act 1991

Private Plan Change 34 (PC 34) proposes to change the Selwyn District Plan (Rural and Township Maps and Plan Text) to rezone 5.93ha of existing Rural (Outer Plains) land to Living 1 to facilitate the residential subdivision and development of the site. The subject land is located at 134 High Street (Lots 1-15 50-62 88-89 DP 825) at the south western edge of Southbridge bounded by High Street, Brook Street and Bellfield/Robinson Street (unformed). PC 34 proposes the following amendments to the Selwyn District Plan:

- · Amends the District Planning Maps to rezone the subject land to a Living 1 zone
- Incorporate an Outline Development Plan to coordinate and guide the future development of the site, including noise mitigation on the north western boundary of the site.
- Incorporates subdivision rules and assessment matters to manage the effects of any future development on the site.

Any submitter who is not satisfied with the Council's decision may then appeal to the Environment Court.
