Roading Resealing programme

A list of roads which will have resealing work completed by June 2015 is now available on the Council's website, www.selwyn.govt.nz.

Resealing work is undertaken during the spring, summer and autumn when weather conditions help the seal to set. Resealing work is now underway at a number of sites.

Resealing work will be undertaken on 60 roads and a total of 76 kilometres of roads will be resealed. Of this, 11 kilometres of resealing work is extra work which was funded by the \$60 targeted roading rate introduced in July. This funding will enable the resealing of sections of these roads:

- Selwyn Road (from Shands Road to Lincoln Rolleston Road)
- Lincoln Rolleston Road (from Selwyn Road to Lowes Road)
- Springston Rolleston Road (from Rattletrack Road to Dynes Road)
- Weedons Road (from Ellesmere Junction Road to Shands Road)

4 kilometres of road rehabilitation work will also be undertaken at five sites – this work involves the road base being reconstructed, the surface levelled and then resealed.

The roads where rehabilitation work will be done are Selwyn Lake, Southbridge Leeston, Leeston Dunsandel, Old Tai Tapu and Feredays roads. Construction is currently under way on Selwyn Lake Road. The roading targeted rate has allowed the Council to increase road rehabilitation work planned from 1 kilometres to 4 kilometres.

Agrecovery will be collecting agrichemical containers for recycling at Farmlands, 40 South Terrace, Darfield on Monday 24 November from 9am - 2pm. A free barbeque will be available at this event.

Containers for recycling must be 0 - 60 litres in size, free of chemical residue, dirt and other contamination inside and out, and still have the label on. Please ensure containers are well drained after triple rinsing.
