Pest Research and Control business in IZONE

We would like to update the community on the information we currently have about the site owned by Pest Control Research NZ on Centrum Place at Izone.

The Council has not received a resource consent application for the manufacturing of 1080-baited pellets and we understand there is no manufacturing taking place at the site currently. If the property owner wished to use the premises for manufacturing a pest control product containing 1080, or storage of significant quantities of that product, they would first need to obtain a resource consent from the Council.

The consent would include conditions to ensure that any operation involving hazardous substances was managed to minimise the risk of environmental or health impacts. Any resource consent application would also be likely to be referred to an independent consultant for assessment. The owner would also need to meet any requirements of other regulatory agencies relating to the manufacture or storage of the material (for example, the Environmental Protection Authority).

Council staff have been in contact with the site owners last week to advise them of the District Plan requirements for hazardous substances.

Selwyn Community Board News

Progress is being made on the Rolleston Railway Station beautification works. Last weekend a group of volunteers and community board members carried out planting work and laid sleepers to create a garden alongside the railway platform. We are very grateful to the volunteers and local businesses who have provided materials and assistance to enable the work to be completed.

The next works we have planned as part of the beautification work are to complete further planting work, add some picnic tables and rubbish bins and create a barrier between the station and the State Highway.
