## Selwyn District Council Temporary use of existing building to provide temporary accommodation

Pursuant to Section 7 of the Canterbury Earthquake (Resource Management Act Permitted Activities) Order 2011.

That the use of an existing building to provide temporary accommodation is a permitted activity.

The subject property is Lot 15 DP 340435, located at 179 Otahuna Road, Tai Tapu.

The operation of this site shall, pursuant to Section 7 of the above Order, at all times comply with the following standards:

1. That the original dwelling (shown as "pottery studio" on the plan attached to application 145030) shall be used to provide the temporary accommodation.
2. That temporary accommodation shall be provided only to those occupants named in the application.
3. That the temporary accommodation shall be decommissioned with all kitchen facilities removed including the water pipes capped and the sink bench, pantry and cupboards removed no later than:
  - a. within three months of no longer being required by the occupants identified in the application; or
  - b. at the expiry of the Canterbury Earthquake (Resource Management Act Permitted Activities) Order 2011 whichever is the earlier.
4. The activity will **not** create any significant adverse effects that will cause nuisance for occupiers of surrounding sites. If in the opinion of a Council Officer, any significant adverse effects do arise, then the Council can impose additional requirements or conditions to avoid, remedy or mitigate those adverse effects.
