

The exhibition runs until Thursday 27 March and the Gallery is open daily (except Mondays) from 10am to 4pm for this exhibition.




Form 23 Notice of removal of part of designation Sections 182 and 196, Resource Management Act 1991

Selwyn District Council gives notice that it no longer requires the following part of a designation:

The area defined on the plan below that comprises part of Designation 417 as described in the Selwyn District Plan. The current designation is for a Local Purpose (Community and Recreation Facilities) Reserve and forms part of the 'Foster Recreation Park' site located between Goulds Road and Springston-Rolleston Road, Rolleston. The area to be removed from the designation comprises 6.7129 hectares and is part of Lot 1 DP 79578 and Section 1 SO 433412 contained in CFR 533853 and CB45C/921

The Council has agreed to sell this portion of the land to the Ministry of Education for the purposes of establishing a high school, and it is no longer required for the designation purpose. Pursuant to section 182(2) of the Resource Management Act, the Selwyn District Plan has been amended to remove that part of the designation referred to.



Selwyn Central Community Board News Proposed Speed Limit Change – SH1, Burnham Road Aylesbury Road

The Board received an update at its last meeting on the above intersection which is next on NZTA's list in its 2014 national trial of Rural Intersection Activated Warning Signs. The intention of this trial is to reduce the severity of accidents at rural intersections considered high risk. The device will reduce the operating speed on the main road.

As vehicles on Burnham or Aylesbury Roads approach the intersection, the warning signs which will be located 150 metres from the intersection on SH1 will display a 70km per hour speed limit or a 'slow down' message will be displayed and an open road speed limit will apply. A start date is to be confirmed.

Rolleston Railway Station

The Selwyn Central Community Board is very keen to use the Rolleston railway station for promoting Selwyn District to tourists, look at the option of displaying local artwork, toilet facilities and interpretation panels showing our history, the town and our growth. A public meeting will be held in the near future to discuss moving this project forward.

RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT 1991

Because of their possible environmental effects, many activities need a resource consent from the Council.

You have the right to inspect the full consent application received by council at any Council Service Centre during normal office hours or view on the council website www.selwyn.govt.nz and make a submission supporting or opposing the proposal.

Any person may make a submission but a person, who is a trade competitor of the applicant, may do so only if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the application relates that (a) adversely affects the environment and

(b) does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
