Resident's survey

The Council is now running its 2014 Resident's Survey.

Every year the Council runs a resident's survey which seeks feedback on what residents think of Council services like parks and roads and the Council's future plans for the district.

This year's survey also includes questions on the Council's Smoke Free Policy as well as people's thoughts on pokie machine gambling.

The survey seeks responses from around 1,000 randomly chosen residents by telephone. This year those asked to take part will also be given an option to complete the survey online.

Dog Registration Starts in July

It's that time of year again when all dog owners must ensure that their dogs are registered. The penalties for non-registration can be expensive.

All dogs older than three months must be registered every year (July-June) under the Dog Control Act 1996. The re-registration notice will not arrive in your inbox or letterbox until 1 July or just after.

Registration Fee (Inclusive of GST)

The 2014/15 fee is due on 1 July 2014 and may be paid during the month of July. This may be done via a payment link when the form is emailed, telebanking/internet banking, at the Council's Rolleston Headquarters or service centres in Leeston, Darfield, Lincoln or Rolleston Library. Alternatively, you may use the prepaid return envelope provided with vour registration form.

If paid by 31 July 2014, the registration fee applicable is:

- \$35 for the first dog
- \$25 for each additional dog owned by the same person and held at the same locality.

Payment after 31 July 2014 will incur a penalty and the registration fee applicable is:

- \$50 for the first dog
- \$35 for each additional dog owned by the same person and held at the same locality.



Change of Address

If you have changed address since last year's registration, please contact the Council on 347 2800 or 318 8338 so that your details can be confirmed.

Tag & Collar Fees (Inclusive of GST)

The fee for a replacement dog tag is \$5 and for a dog collar \$7-\$9 depending on the size.

(These fees and charges are set under Sections 37, 38 and 68 of the Dog Control Act 1996.)

Public Notice by the Minister of Education Partially Operative Selwyn District Plan

Section 173, Resource Management Act 1991

Under section 172 of the Resource Management Act 1991 Selwyn District Council has received a decision from the Minister of Education on the Notice of Requirement for a new primary school to the west of Rolleston.

The decision is to designate approximately 4.5 hectares on the western edge of the Rolleston Township on the corner of Burnham School Road and Dunns Crossing Road for educational purposes.

The decision on the Notice of Requirement may be inspected during opening hours at any of the Council's service centres or libraries.

Rights of Appeal on this decision are outlined in Section 174 of the Act but are only available to the Council, submitters and the land owner. Appeals must be lodged with the Environment Court within 15 working days of this notice of decision.

Roadsides are not car yards

Selwyn District Council is reminding vehicle owners not to advertise their cars for sale on roadsides. There has been an increase in the number of cars parked on roadsides with 'for sale' signs around the district, most recently in Prebbleton.

The Council's Traffic and Parking Bylaw prohibits the selling of cars on any public roadside in the District without Council consent, which is unlikely to be given.


This practice is not allowed because it can be a safety issue if the parked vehicle distracts or blocks the path of motorists, cyclists or pedestrians or the sight lines of motorists.


Council staff have noticed several vehicles displaying these signs around the District and are putting a reminder note on their front windscreen to remind owners that it is not okay to park and display these signs. Breaching the bylaw could result in a fine.
