Are you eligible for a Rates Rebate?

If your gross household income to 31 March 2013 was around \$23,870 or less and you pay the rates on the property you live at, you may qualify for a rates rebate.

If your income exceeds this amount you could still be entitled to a rebate depending on the total cost of your rates and the number of dependents you have.

You can check out the rates rebate calculator and example tables on the Department of Internal Affairs website www.ratesrebates.govt.nz or contact the Council on 03 327 2800 or 03 318 8338 for more information. You will need to provide your gross income to 31 March 2013.

Rates rebate applications for the current rating year can be accepted until 30 June 2014.

DRINKING WATER STANDARDS COMPLIANCE

As part of compliance with the Drinking-water Standards for New Zealand 2005 (Revised 2008), Selwyn District Council is legally required to publish the following notice.

DRINKING WATER Public Notice

Some plumbing fittings have the potential to allow minute traces of metals to accumulate in water standing in the fittings for several hours.

Although the health risk is small, the Ministry of Health recommends that you flush a mugful of water from your drinking water tap each morning, before use, to remove any metals that may have dissolved from the plumbing fittings. We recommend this simple precaution for all households, including those on public and private water supplies.
