Events Funding Available

Applications to Selwyn District Council's Events Fund are now open. \$40,000 is available in the fund to support events that are held in Selwyn which are open to the public.

The fund was established last year and supported 17 events including the Darfield Country Xmas in the Park, Hororata Highland Games, Rolleston Community Fireworks Night, Children's Day, Enviro Ellesmere – Themes Exposé and the NZ Young Farmer's Competition.

To be eligible for a grant, events need to meet these criteria:

- the event attracts local, regional and / or international visitors
- it contributes to key benefits identified in the Council's events policy
- it helps to increase the range and diversity of events in Selwyn
- it promotes the Selwyn district

Events should preferably be run by a not for profit organisation with charitable status, although applications from community organisations and individuals may be accepted.

Kirwee water update

The Kirwee water supply is operating as normal while repair work is being scheduled. The water supply is no longer being chlorinated and is safe to drink. The supply also has adequate capacity and no restrictions on water use are in place.

Repair work was scheduled for this scheme earlier this year and there has been some delay to this work due to contractor availability. The reservoirs for the scheme have now been inspected by a qualified engineer who has identified and recommended routine repairs be made, such as renewing and replacing pipework and some additional measures as a precaution to ensure the supply is fully secured from infiltration.

The Council will write to Kirwee residents to update them once the repairs have been completed.
